WHAT IS A SUMMER READ?

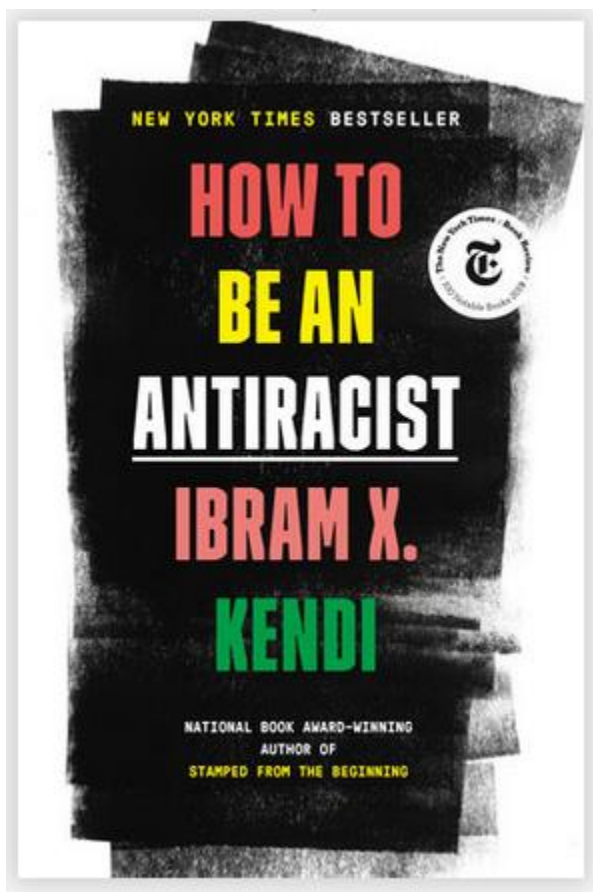
Read or listen to the book over the summer, attend a discussion in the Fall
